



Morrow County Technical Review Boards

Morrow County offers property owners two, free Technical Review Boards: one for residential property and the second for commercial or industrial property.

Purpose

These boards serve as a "one-stop shop" for property owners to get all the information they need in the areas of zoning, planning, development, engineering, sewer, water and soil drainage. The boards also help ensure that lot splits for residential, commercial and industrial development are consistent with the Morrow County Comprehensive Land Use Plan, county or township zoning and County Subdivision Regulations.

Residential Technical Review Board

This board meets on Tuesday mornings to review residential lot splits. Board members are:

- Planning Office staff
- County or township zoning inspector (if applicable)
- Soil & Water Conservation
- Health Department
- Engineer's Office

Commercial/Industrial Technical Review Board

This board meets as needed. Board members are:

- Regional Planning Commission chairman and Planning staff
- Development director
- County or township zoning commission chairman and county or township zoning inspector (if applicable)
- Soil & Water Conservation
- Health Department
- Engineer's Office
